Street Sprints on Friday the 28th

Start the most exciting weekend of racing in the Midwest right with old fashioned street sprints. Riders will go up Meridian Street in newly renovated downtown Anderson. Great prizes will be awarded to the top racers in the following categories: CAT 1/2/3, CAT 3, CAT 4, Citizens, MAS 30+, Women and to the top 5 in the MAS 60+, 65+, 70+, 75+, 80+, and Women 60+ categories. Starts at 2:15 p.m. at the Wesley Free Methodist Church. Restrooms available at the church. Starting order will be as follows: Mas 30+, Cat 3, Mas 40+, Mas 60+ group, Citizens and so on.

Riders will start every 30 seconds. No missing your starting time! Will receive time as you register for the road race. The course will follow the road race loop and end at the 6 mile mark. Points will be scored out to 30 places, with half the normal IRS Value for points. See web for info. Cost to do just the TT is \$15.00 Awards to the top 3 overall fastest times of the day.
