**DIRECTIONS:** (from I-90-South of Rockford, IL): Exit at Genoa Road (north). Take Genoa Road north to Highway 20. Right (East) on Highway 20 to Garden Prairie Road. North on Garden Prairie Road approximately 1/4 mile to Kiswaukee Elementary School parking lot. Do not park on Garden Prairie Road or Highway 20.

**REGISTRATION:** will open at 7:00am in the school parking lot. Entry fee for ABR Members is \$20 and for non-ABR Members it is \$24. An Annual Membership may be purchased at the race for \$25 and will be good for the remainder of 2006 and all of 2007. Make checks payable to 'ABR' and send to: ABR, PO Box 487, Tinley Park, IL 60477-0487. Starting order is based on order of registration. First to register is first out.

**First rider starts at 8:30am and remaining riders at one minute intervals thereafter.**

**COURSE:** 40 Kilometers, course is out and back. The course is relatively flat with a few rolling hills. Center Line Rule is in force for your safety. Riders are only allowed to warm up north of Highway 20 away from the Start / Finish area. Highway 20 is a busy road so take care in crossing this street.
