Location

Ft. Benjamin Harrison State Park is located on the NE side of Indy. Take I-465 to the NE side, get off at exit 40, and take 56th Street East. Travel ~1.8 miles then turn left onto Post Road. Go to the end of the road (0.4 miles) and turn left into Ft. Harrison State Park. Follow Signs. Free admission to the park for racers.

Begins at 6:35 a.m. at the Fort. Under the Big Tent. \$15.00 for a second race. Register

When	Start times will be assigned at Ft. Ben race registration. First rider will go off at 4:00 p.m. All racers will have the option of going out of the IRS trailer. If inclement weather persists, the TT will be postponed to early Sunday morning at 6:15 a.m. before the Fairgrounds Race.			
Where	An out and back course along Fall Creek Parkway. First rider will go off at 4:00 p.m. with the rest to follow in 30-second intervals. Rider's start time will be contingent on when they sign up at the Ft. Ben Race. Not a closed course.			
Parking	At the Woodbridge Office Building, 5435 Emerson Way, near O'Malia's and CVS. Park around the Woodbridge Office Building and then ride your bike to the TT using the bike path at the east end of the parking lot to take you under the road. Start/Finish line is about ¼ mile from there - look for signs. A great setting to move fast through the nice homes on Fall Creek Parkway. Very important: follow the signs to the TT from Ft. Ben RR! Do not drive on the TT course! TT is on E. Fall Creek Parkway N. Go to cvs.com and enter zip 46226E. Fall Creek Parkway for directions.			
Awards	A total of 30 IRS points will be awarded to the top finisher, 2 nd place will get 29 points, 3 rd place will receive 27 points, etc. all the way down to 30 th place -1 point for that. In addition, bonus points will be awarded to the top 3 riders in their respective category (5,3,1).

Things to Know:

- 1. You must do all 3 stages to be eligible for overall awards.
- 2. The person with the highest point totals (based on IRS points) wins in their respective category. The TT will count as third of the normal IRS points. Tie-breaker will be based on Indiana State Fairgrounds placing.
- 3. New this year—longer races, Juniors Race, bigger purse in some categories, and three point primes in the road races. In addition, breakaway point primes will be awarded--finish a minute up on the "pack" and you will earn 10 bonus points for each person in the breakaway group. 3 Point primes for the Crit as well. Chip timing for the hand cyclist's races.
- 4. Upon registering at the Ft. Ben Race, you will receive your TT start time. TT course is out-and-back for a sum of roughly less than 5 miles. Great road to hammer on! A few miles from Ft. Ben.
- 5. Cost is \$65.00 for all 3 stages except for Citizens where the cost is \$55.00. Cost per stage if not noted is \$30.00 which includes ABR Insurance, etc. TT cost is \$10.00. Hand Cycle racers cost is \$60.00. Register at www.racelistings.com \$10.00 late fee if you don't pre-register. Registration closes on August 20th. Can register the day of. Hand cyclists please use www.bikereg.com to register. Free pass into the Fairgrounds for the first 25 people who register via racelistings.com.
