



RESULTS August 3, 2008



Great weather and a friendly neighborhood tree lined technical course greeted the bicycle racers arriving for the Elgin Cycling Classic in Elgin, IL. The racecourse bordered Lord's Park along the Start/Finish area. From the start line the riders rode south into "The Chicane" of left turn, downhill into a right turn, then a short flat stretch and right up a short hill. The course was flat heading west to the right turn to head north on the long back stretch which descended to a very quick right - right turn before reaching the finishing straight that was slightly uphill. Except for "The Chicane" the course was several lanes wide.

PRO Category 1-2

Seeing these top riders fly around the course for one hour plus two laps of their race provided a real insight into just how fast and great they handle a bicycle. Diving into "The Chicane" no more than two abreast, maintaining the speed up the hill afterward, riding the far left side of the road on the back stretch before the right turn, then swinging wide only inches away from the curb as they peddle to the next right only moments away. There were many break attempts on the home and backstretch. Clark Priebe and Frank Dierking were able to make a successful break and lap the field with the help of teammates in the field riding slow at the front. With less than a quarter of the race remaining they only needed to stay with the field to secure 1st and 2nd. Another break was forming and getting larger with Frank, his Team and many other teams but it collapsed. The last lap saw all the sprinters and their lead out riders moving to the front, which caused the speed to increase by leaps. Sean Metz took the field sprint followed by teammate Ben and a new upcoming rider Ryan Freund (won the Cat 3 race earlier).
