ROTY is WIIL ASSN. Rider Of The Year, points are earned at MATTS, TOI/W and select events throughout the season in IL and WI events held with ABR.

The Kenosha Velosport Race was held at a new 1.1-mile course in the Industrial Park of Kenosha, Kenosha, WI. This is not a flat course, you are going up gradually from start line to just beyond the first corner. The gradual downhill begins and continues a little past the third turn. Now the gradual uphill begins all the way to the finish line. The course is just short of 4 lanes wide. The surface is cement.

For months the course was under snow and ice and the street surface condition was a concern once it melted. Event Promoter Han Huang of Kenosha Velosport asked the City of Kenosha if they could help remove some snow, ice and do some road patching. A HUGE THANK YOU to the City of Kenosha street maintenance crews who came out on Friday two days before the event to remove snow and ice, patch holes and sweep the course. They did an excellent job. On Saturday they spread ice melt and sand to melt the 1 to 2" of new snow. Han and Sarah Huang and Mike Riva swept the course at start area and turns Saturday afternoon and Sunday morning more members helped.

Although there was no University Indoor facilities like the Club had at UW Parkside, the Club did have a large heated tent for registration, results, awards, a small food service and to drop in to warm up. Hey, we should all be acclimated to the cold after this long winter. But where is Spring?
