ALL RIDERS ON A TEAM >>WEAR IDENTICAL JERSEYS<< MUST WEAR Helmet while riding bicycle.

Bicycles must be no more then 2 meters long and 75 cm wide and must have a working brake on each wheel. Basically a Road, Time Trial or Triathlon bike is acceptable.

First Team Starts: At 9:01am and following teams at two-minute intervals thereafter Start times are assigned in order of postmark or online date and lastly day of event.

Support vehicle is allowed, No motor-pacing, no interfering or blocking of other teams. Teams may draft within their team but may not draft other teams. Teams may pass other teams when it is safe to pass.

Course: Start area is at Waltham School, 946 N 33rd Road, Waltham Township, and LaSalle County, IL. THIS COURSE IS OPEN TO TRAFFIC. Corner Marshal at each turn and two straight through intersection. Finish line is just east of start line. This is an out and back course on mostly flat Illinois farmland roads consisting of asphalt and chip seal road surface in very good condition, which are lightly traveled. Promoter reserves right to adjust course if conditions warrant. Course Map available race day.

Directions to course: Take Interstate 80 to Utica exit 81 – IL-178. Go north on IL-178 approximately 3 miles to County highway 33 (N. 33rd Road also known as Waltham Wallace Rd) Turn East (right) onto County highway 33 and go 1 mile to Waltham District School at 946 N. 33rd Rd.
