4/25 Tour de Granville Township Granville, Ohio This is the first race in the three race series inside the Torelli Ohio Spring Classics Series. We are calling it the Three City Tour with stops in Granville – April 25, Newark- May 2, and Heath- May 10. There are over-all awards for the Three City Tour as well as points for the Spring Series.

This is a nice course that is not to hard, but not flat either. Plenty of Rollers, and depending on the wind direction, can turn into Grinders. The start /finish area is closed to traffic and on good pavement.

This course and location is good for beginners, but as some challenge for the Elite folks too.

It has been used for years, and 2008 was part of the Tour of Ohio.

<u>Directions-</u> Take St.Rt. 661 North from Granville, Just north of Denison University turn left on New Burg St. and go past the High School /Middle School ¹/₂ mile to the Intermediate School. The Intermediate School is on the edge of town. Start /finish area at the Intermediate School.

<u>Course Description-</u> The Tour of Granville is conducted on the rolling roads north of Granville in Licking County. You can expect the tough grind back to Granville on Burg Street Rd. There will be races for all ages and abilities over a race distance of 20- 50 miles. The course is 6.7 miles in length.

<u>Here's the scoop-</u> The prize money for our Spring Classic events is guaranteed in each category. Registration begins at 90 minutes before the first race and closes 15 minutes before each race. There is no late fees, but there is a discount if you pre-reg. at www.truesport.com.
