

Kenosha Velosport did a great job in searching venues to continue their Spring Training Criterium Series. Of course there is a BIG THANKS to the City of Pleasant Prairie, WI for their assistance in making this event possible.

The weather was sunny all day, temps at 9am 38, 10am 44, 11am 47, 12n 48, 1 to 3pm 49 and hit 50 at 4pm.

This D shaped .7 mile course dropsto1st turn and actually drops gradually to the north side then after turn 4 you climb to highest point and descend a bit to finish line. Perhaps 10 or 20 feet elevation change.

**Location:** LakeView Corporate Park is located in Pleasant Prairie, WI. Take I-94 to Hwy 165, go east. Turn on left on 80<sup>th</sup> Ave., Parking at 10303 80<sup>th</sup> Ave, Pleasant Prairie, WI

Racing started at 9am with the combined field of Master 60 through 80+ and a second field of Master Women 40 through 70+, Women Open & Women Cat 4/5.

Kallas and Vichotka took the front early and gradually increased the pace making a break with Stern on their heels, but eventually is was Kallas and Vichotka with a small field behind that was breaking up.

Just a few laps into the race Loberg, Robertson and Moorhouse break from the field. Other riders made a few attempts to catch in the next 7 laps with no luck. Boba and Schouten get away at 11 laps gradually gaining on the three man break ahead. Two laps later the field breaks into three groups. A lap later Loberg, Robertson and Moorhouse catch the 3<sup>rd</sup> field and immediately Loberg takes off and catches the 2<sup>rd</sup> field. Robertson and Moorhouse cannot stay in contact with Loberg and two laps later Boba and Schouten catch the 3<sup>rd</sup> field with Robertson and Moorhouse. With Loberg pushing the pace of 2<sup>rd</sup> field, he drops them in 5 laps then goes on to catch 1<sup>st</sup> field where he remains to finish first having lapped all except Robertson, Moorehouse, Boba and Schouten. The 1st field held 5 riders for 6 through 10<sup>th</sup>. 2<sup>rd</sup> field finishes with 5 riders 11<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> and then the 3<sup>rd</sup> field with the top four and riders 17<sup>th</sup> on finishes. Great race Erik Loberg.
