August 14 (Saturday): Registration begins at 9:30am and continues until 15 minutes before scheduled event.

10:00 am: 200m time trials (must ride a time for each category entered)
 11:00 am: 500m / 1000m time trials (may be 2 up)
 12:00 pm: Sprints (1st and 2nd rounds)
 1:00 pm: Pursuits (short to long distances)
 2:00 pm: Sprints (Semi and final round)

August 15 (Sunday) Registration begins at 9:30am and continues until 15 minutes before scheduled event.

10:00 am: Events not completed from Saturday.
 10:15 am: Team Sprints and Team Time Trials
 11:00 am: Points races (order to be determined on race day)

Direction to the Washington Bowl Velodrome – Kenosha, WI

From Milwaukee (I-94) or from Chicago (I-294) toll-road / Hwy 41 to **exit # 340** (Kenosha) Hwy142/ S. East 6 miles on Hwy S/Washington Rd. to 22nd Av. Turn right on 22nd and then immediately left into Washington Park.

Awards

National Track Jerseys (FIAC or ABR) to the overall winners for each Omnium winner. The winner of the Jersey must be a FIAC association (ABR,ORBA,ACA,CBR) annual member. Overall winner in each category will be determined based on a points system from each of the individual event in that category. The top 6 places in each event will score points (7-5-4-3-2-1). Riders do not need to compete in all races in order to win the overall Jersey. The highest points in the last event working backwards will break any ties. Categories and events may be combined if there are less than 4 in a category. In addition, medals will be awarded for the top 5 places for each Omnium event.

Special Rules:

Road **bicycles** may be used for timed events only, no shifting allowed (gear you start is the gear you must finish). The 200 m time trial is an event in itself and counts towards the overall. Times from 200m will be used to seed for sprints. (Must inform officials before each ride which category time used for)
 In timed events (except 200m) riders will be allowed only one restart in the first 30 meters for any reason.
 Any other special rules will be posted at registration.

Registration and Entries:

Junior, Women, Master Women category: \$10 for each event or \$ 40 for all five events per category.
 Seniors and Masters: \$15 for each event or \$ 50 for all five events per category.
 Team Events: \$5 per rider per team.
