August 27 (Saturday): Registration begins at 8:30am and continues until 15 minutes before scheduled event.

- 10:00 am: 500m / 1000m time trials (may be 2 up)
- 11:00 am: 200m time trials (must ride a time for each category entered)
- 11:30 pm: Sprints
- 2:00 pm: Pursuits (short to long distances)
- 3:00 pm: Team Sprints and Team Time Trials
- 4:00 am: Points races (order and groups to be determined on race day)

August 28 (Sunday) Rain Date: Continuation from Saturday schedule until finished. Start at 9:00am.

Direction to the Washington Bowl Velodrome – Kenosha, WI

From Milwaukee (I-94) or from Chicago (I-294) toll-road / Hwy 41 to **exit # 339 Hwy E** or **exit # 342 Hwy 158 and follow the detour signs back to East Hwy 142** Note: **Exit # 340 Hwy 142 / S is closed for reconstruction on the east side of I-94.** I suggest going east on Hwy E or Hwy 158 to Green Bay Rd and then back to Hwy 142, then east on Hwy 142 / S / Washington Rd. to 22nd Av. Turn right on 22nd and then immediately left into Washington Park.

Awards

National Track Jerseys (FIAC or ABR) to the overall winners for each Omnium winner and 2-5th places will receive medals for there overall Omnium placing. The winner of the Jersey must be a FIAC association (ABR, ORBA, ACA, and CBR) annual member. The overall winner in each category will be determined based on a points system from each of the individual events in that category. The top 5 places in each event will score points (7-5-3-2-1). Riders do not need to compete in all races in order to win the overall Jersey. The highest points in the last event working backwards will break any ties. Categories and events may be combined if there are less than 3 in a category.

Special Rules:

Road **bicycles** may be used for timed events only, no shifting allowed (gear you start is the gear you must finish). The 200 m time trial is an event in itself and counts towards the overall. Times from 200m will be used to seed for sprints. (Must inform officials before each ride which category time used for) In timed events (except 200m) riders will be allowed only one restart in the first 30 meters for any reason after that point restarts will only be allowed for a mechanical condition of the bicycle. Any other special rules will be posted at registration.

Registration and Entries:

\$15 for each individual event entered (max of \$50 per person per category), not including Team Events:

\$10 per rider for Team events.

Advance registration is not necessary but will close 15 minutes before the scheduled start of that event.
