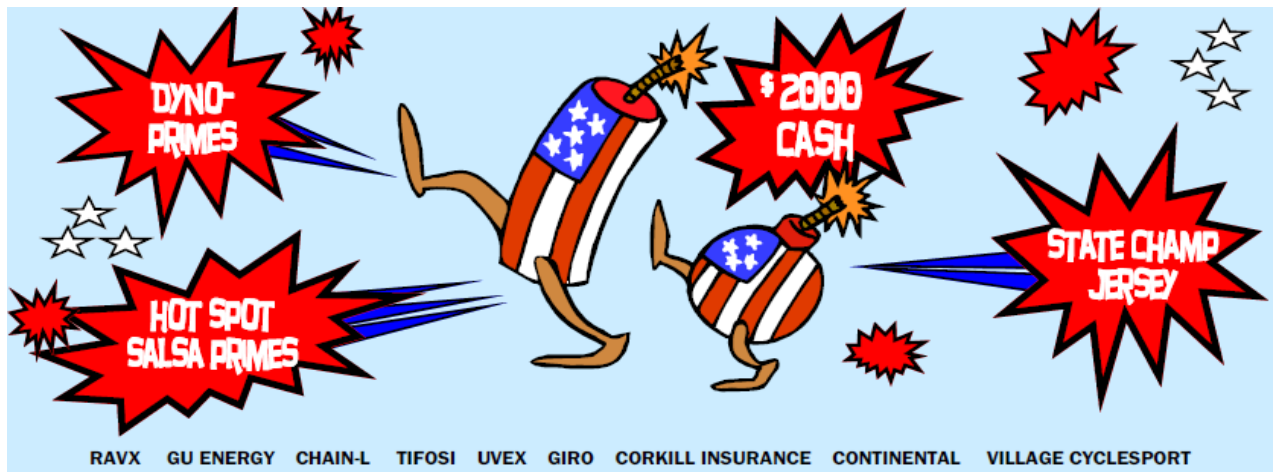

Last event of the day to contest was the Category 1-2-3 race, a 60 min plus 5 lap battle. 11min into the race Tim Speciale, Shawn Metz, Ryan Zook and Eric Tomlinson were making a break. Shawn's chain wheel breaks and he is out. Down to three, but perhaps not thinking it would last, as they appeared to be just riding a steady pace without any urgency. 5 laps later Scott Pearson flies off the front for a preme and keeps on going catching the break on the next lap! 4 riders away and each capable of riding fast for the entire race, the time had come for the field to react or hang on for only 5th place. Attempts were made from the field, solo riders launching off perhaps hoping more would join in, but nothing came together till Chris Mosora went to the front and started to time trial. The chase field was Mosora, Scott Arrigoni, Todd Metz, Adam Lesniakowski, Trevor Lister, Andrew Lister, Vic Rentas & Robert Kron. This chase was driving the fast lane chasing after the 4 man break. But the break appeared to be riding as a 4 man ttt. At 45 min into the race the Lead 4 had lapped the field and moved to the front. Were they now after the 8 rider chase?? Two laps later the Mosora tries to break from his chase group but looses his chain, comes into the wheel pit seeking a quick repair to rejoin his chase group, confusion erupts, is it broke, bent, definitely chain is jammed on a chainwheel guide for a single front chainwheel. Wheel pit Official gives Chris the green light to rejoin break. After rejoining chase Chris proceeds to break away from chase group with Adam and Todd on his wheel. The three remain away to the finish. The Chase Field finishes together ahead of field. After Chief Judge and Referee discussed Chris's trouble the free lap was removed. The field sprint with the 4 leaders was fast Danny Robertson won he sprint but that got him 12th, Eric Tomlinson came in 2nd but won the race and ABR IL State Championship. Eric's breakaway team came across the line directly behind him. Great race.
